



Privacy Policy

Dark Rhino Security, Inc. (“Dark Rhino Security” or “we”) is committed to protecting the privacy of the personally identifiable we collect from you as you use this website (the “site”). We have detailed our commitment in this Privacy Policy. By submitting information, you agree to Dark Rhino Security’s use of personally identifiable information.

What personal information is collected?

Dark Rhino Security collects personally identifiable information on certain areas of the site when users enter their information in the contact form. The personally identifiable information collected may include, without limitation, name, mailing and e-mail addresses and phone numbers.

How may my Personal Info be used?

Dark Rhino Security uses your personally identifiable information to process your request for contact. We may keep any of your personally identifiable information on file and use it to contact you. Dark Rhino Security may also use personally identifiable information in analyzing Site user behavior in order measure interest in specific items posted on our Site. The e-mail addresses provided through the contact page allow Dark Rhino Security to send e-mails to individual based on their request. Dark Rhino Security uses personal Info collected from cookies and IP addresses as described below. Dark Rhino Security does not sell any of your personal information.

Are cookies and IP addresses used?

The Site uses cookies to identify you and your interests and to track your usage of the Site. Cookies are small pieces of text stored on your computer. The cookies help us understand which browser you are using and where you have been on the Site and potentially redirected to. Dark Rhino Security also logs IP addresses or the location of computers on the Internet to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer the Site.

Is personally identifiable information disclosed to third parties?

Dark Rhino Security will not intentionally disclose (and will take commercially reasonable steps to prevent the accidental disclosure of) your Personal Info to third parties (i.e., person or entities that are not affiliates of Dark Rhino Security), whether for such third parties’ marketing purposes or otherwise, subject only to the following four exceptions:

1. Dark Rhino Security may disclose your personal information to third parties as required or permitted by the laws, rules, and regulations of any nation, state, or other applicable jurisdiction;
2. Dark Rhino Security may disclose your personal information to third parties who deliver information from us to you for the purpose of performing such delivery;
3. Dark Rhino Security may disclose your personal information if, in connection with submitting the information, you consent to such disclosure;
4. Dark Rhino Security may disclose contact information for you in response to inquiries by bona-fide rights owners in connection with allegations of infringement of copyright or other proprietary rights arising from information you have posted on the Site or otherwise provided to Dark Rhino Security;
5. If Dark Rhino Security and/or any of its affiliates merges with or sells substantially all of its assets or a majority of its equity to a third party, information collected by Dark Rhino Security or such affiliates on their Web sites may be disclosed to and owned by the merged entity or third party.
